Exhibit Spaces

Spring Expo offers both indoor and outdoor exhibit spaces. A limited number of electrical outlets are available to indoor spaces. Outdoor spaces are much larger and therefore better suited large equipment/displays, plant sales, and large livestock. We cannot guarantee access to electrical outlets to outdoor exhibitors. Live Animals

Exhibitors are allowed to include live animals. Grassy outdoor spaces are available for those bringing hoofstock/farm animals and/or dogs. Please indicate your desire to bring live animals on your registration form and any special requests regarding your exhibit space. Please include the number of live animals and species that you are bringing to help us better meet your needs and have a proper space available when you arrive on the day of the expo. Domestic mammals must be accompanied by documentation of required vaccinations.

Exhibitor Cost

All (indoor or outdoor) exhibit spaces cost \$40/space. Please indicate any special requirements for your space on your completed exhibitor registration form. We encourage creativity and will make every effort to accommodate special requests, but cannot guarantee that all requests will be met. Bristol Aggie program advisory board members receive a free exhibit space.
